Market report for Friday, September 16th. We sold about 1,300 head for the day with 121 head being weighup cows and bulls and the balance being feeder cattle. On a very light run of weighups this week the market was stronger. The top end of the cows going on feed were \$80.50-\$94.50. The best of the slaughter cows were sold in a wide range from \$70.50-\$90.50. The bulk of the big bulls going to slaughter were mostly \$89.50-\$111.50.

We had a nice run of feeders this week with some fancy spring calves at the start of the sale followed by several groups of fall calves with lots of packages of spayed and open heifers. Some active in house bidding and timely internet support saw some good results. Really nice steers weighing 762# brought \$200.75 and the bigger brothers weighing 858# brought \$185.75. Another nice home raised set of steers weighing 906# brought \$180. For the day we got along okay once again in spite of higher corn prices and continued volatility in both the commodity and financial markets.
