

Crawford Livestock Market



Market report for Friday, July 15, 2022. We sold a total of 722 head with about 525 head being weigh up cows and bulls and the balance being feeder cattle. The post 4th of July weigh up market is typically softer and this week was no exception. There has been in the last two weeks a very significant amount of cows going to slaughter across the country. Here at the barn, the top end of the cows going back on feed were a little softer ranging from \$77.50-\$88.00. The top end of the slaughter cows were \$72.50-\$90.50. The next cut of slaughter cows were \$62-\$75. Big killer bulls were also down a bit but still managed to sell for \$100-\$112. The thin, gimpy bulls sold from \$83.50-\$105.50. Young, cutting bulls topped out around \$161-\$166.

We had package trade on yearlings with the flagship being a fancy pot load of spayed heifers leading the way with 56 black heifers of Mike & Carri Manion's weighing 934# commanding \$166, bringing \$1550 a head.

We had a really nice sale in Reno, Nevada last Monday representing 4,500 head in conjunction with Western Video Market. We sold 1000# steers for over \$1,800 a head, and nice big spayed heifers at \$1,675 per head. We're working on building our next video sale coming up in August in Cheyenne.
