



Market report for Friday, June 10th, 2022. We sold roughly 540 head of weighup cows, bulls, and a nice pair dispersion. Overall the weigh up market was steady to \$4 higher from last week. We sold young pairs with big calves at side from \$1925-\$2025. Short solid mouth pairs topped out at \$1750 and broken mouth pairs went for \$1550.

It was the perfect day for a horse sale with hundreds of bidders in attendance and online our ring was packed! There was excellent quality from beginning to end. The high seller was lot 22 a 4 year old mare named Pep in Her Gold Step brought a healthy \$21,500. An outstanding 3 year old Dual Rey/High Brow Cat bred gelding commanded \$18,500. The top 5 averaged \$17,700. Top 10 averaged \$16,000 and the top 15 averaged \$14,600 and top 20 averaging \$13,350.

The horses overall from start to finish averaged \$8,100. The results were a healthy increase from last year. We went to thank everyone in attendance for a great sale and we'll plan to do it the same week next year. We are off next Friday, June 17^{th.} We will be doing some painting and maintenance! We'll see you next week for a regular cattle sale & special feeder sale.
