

Crawford Livestock Market



Market report for Friday, May 20, 2022. For the day we sold 381 head consisting largely of weighup cows and bulls with package trade on yearlings, late bred cows and pairs. The weighup market was steady to better from last week. Cows in different classes once again traded in a fairly wide range. Good cows being put on feed were \$72.50-\$84.50. The best end of the slaughter cows were \$68-\$84 with a little lesser quality cow bringing \$70.50-\$74.50. The thinner cows that were flawed were \$59.50-\$69.50. The big cows going directly to kill \$78.50-\$87. Another nice run of good bulls that didn't test were off slightly this week but still strong with the top end bringing \$104.50-\$112. Very limited numbers of heiferettes was \$91-\$111.

We had limited trade on yearling heifers with a nice group averaging 743# bringing \$144 and the heavier 805# from the same ranch brought \$140.50. Older broken mouth cows with good calves at side topped out at \$1385 on a limited supply.
