

Crawford Livestock Market

Market report fro Friday, June 28th. We sold 259 head on the day, most being weighup cows and bulls with a few packages of pairs and feeder cattle. Our weighup market continues to be strong and steady from a week ago. Good feeding cows were \$150-\$156.50. The top end of the slaughter cows were \$141-\$154, lower yielding slaughter cows were \$125-\$140. The big slaughter bulls were \$150-\$179.50. Light cutting bulls were mostly \$170-\$217.50. A few 7 weight feeders went through the ring at \$260. A nice run of heiferettes were \$177-\$230.

A few short term pairs with very young, unworked calves sold for \$2300-\$2750. We want to express our sincere thanks to our consignors, buyers and crew for another successful sale. We will be off here at the barn for the next two weeks on July 5th & July 12th. However, we will be representing 8,500 head of yearlings from Western Nebraska, South Dakota & Eastern Wyoming in conjunction with Western Video Market with sale day set for July 9th in Reno, Nevada.
